QUARTERLY MEETING MINUTES

THE MEETING WAS CALLED TO ORDER AT 4:05 P.M. BY NATALIE KETCHUM.

THE MINUTES FROM THE PRVIOUS MEETING WERE APPROVED.

OLD BUSINESS: THE STATUS OF THE PSA WAS DISCUSSED. STONY HILL FIRE DEPT. IS APPLYING FOR THEIR OWN PSA SO THE REPERCUSSIONS OF THAT WERE DISCUSSED. THE REGIONAL PARAMEDIC CONTRACT IS A SEPARATE ISSUE. NATALIE QUESTIONED WHAT IT WOULD COST FOR PARAMEDIC SERVICE IF REDDING IS LEFT ON ITS OWN. CURRENTLY THE 3 FIRE DEPTS. HAVE APPROXIMATELY 1,000 EMS CALL PER YEAR. APPROXIMATELY FIFTY PERCENT OF THOSE WERE ALS.

IT WAS AGREED BY ALL THAT BRPA SHOULD BE DISSOLVED AND A NEW ORGANIZATION STARTED WITH JUST REDDING. "REDDING PARAMEDIC ASSOCIATION" WADE WILL CHECK WITH LEGAL AND RON WILL TALK TO BOB CORRIGAN ABOUT THIS ACTION.

CHARLIE DISCUSSED NORWALK HOSPITAL COMING INTO GEORGETOWN WITH A SATELLITE WALK-IN CLINIC.
